

Decew Gun Club Covid Safety Plan

AN INHERENT RISK OF EXPOSURE TO Covid 19 exists in any place where people are present. Covid 19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By visiting the Decew Gun Club property you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to Covid 19. Please – if you feel unwell, do not attend the range.

- Everyone attending the range must exercise full cough and sneeze etiquette as well as diligent hand hygiene.
- Masks must be worn indoors. Washrooms are open, wash your hands and use your paper hand towel to open the door.
- You must sign in and out EVERY time you are at the range. Signing in and out will help us contact potentially exposed shooters in the event that someone frequenting the range develops the disease.
- Safe distancing on the outdoor range means that one empty shooting position must separate each shooter to create the 2m safe distance from each other.

Bring your own hand sanitizer and use it for signing the log book, when unlocking and locking the gate; before entering your vehicle; or after touching any common range surface. Remember that hand washing with soap is the best sanitizing method. The use of face masks to protect yourself and others is encouraged outdoors. Do not congregate at high traffic points on the property.

If you catch Covid, do not attend the range until you are medically cleared to do so. If you develop Covid within 14 days after attending the range, please notify the membership Chair, Gerry Gamble. We will ensure confidentiality, but will notify those members who may have been exposed. We will also close the range and deep clean as required.
